SUBJECT: CALL TO RECRUIT A CONSULTANT TO DESIGN PROTOCOLS FOR A BASELINE ASSESSMENT OF CHILDHOOD VACCINATION ACTIVITIES IN CAMEROON

The Cameroon Baptist Convention (CBC) Health Services urgently needs the services of a consultant to design tools for a baseline assessment of childhood vaccination services in Cameroon.

The ideal consultant should be a holder of a Post Graduate Degree in Public Health, Sociology, Anthropology, or any related field with excellent monitoring and evaluation skills. He/She should also have at least five years of experience in designing and conducting similar assessments using both quantitative and qualitative approaches.

Interested candidates that meet these requirements should submit an expression of interest as soon as possible including a brief technical proposal and a suggestive budget for the exercise.
