**TERMS OF REFERENCE**

**A. Background**

The Far North Region of Cameroon has been severely affected by the ongoing crisis in the neighboring countries of Nigeria and Chad. This has resulted in the displacement of thousands of people, leaving them vulnerable and in need of assistance. It is in response to this situation that the CBC Health Services in partnership with CBM is implementing the project for **"Building Resilience of Refugees, IDPs, and host community through improved access to Health, Education, and income-generating Activities"** with funding from the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

As part of the strategy to improve access to quality rehabilitation services in the Region, the project will strengthen the capacity of the orthopedic workshop at Mesquine Baptist Hospital Maroua to ensure the maintenance and sustainable production of rehabilitation equipment.

**B. Objective**

The objective of this call to tender is to select a qualified supplier to supply the necessary equipment and consumables for the orthopedic workshop at Mesquine Baptist Hospital, Maroua.
