TERMS OF REFERENCE

A. Background

The Far North Region of Cameroon has been severely affected by the ongoing crisis in the neighboring countries of Nigeria and Chad. This has resulted in the displacement of thousands of people, leaving them vulnerable and in need of assistance. It is in response to this situation that the CBC Health Services in partnership with CBM is implementing the project for Building Resilience of Refugees, IDPs, and host community through improved access to Health, Education, and income-generating Activities with funding from the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

Specifically in healthcare, the project plans to provide access to specialized services in Eye Care, Physiotherapy and Orthopaedics care, Ear and Hearing Care and Mental Health, both at facility and community levels. To achieve this objective, investments will be made to adapt and equip targeted services at Meskine Baptist Hospital Maroua to increase on its infrastructural capacity and improve the quality of the services offered by these departments.

B. Objective

The objective of this call to tender is to select a qualified supplier to supply the necessary equipment and consumables for specialized services (Eye Care, Ear and Hearing Care and Mental Health) at Meskine Baptist Hospital, Maroua.

C. Scope of work

This tender covers the supply of the following equipment and consumables for the Orthopedic workshop in Meskine.

- Have a proven track record of delivering high-quality equipment and services
- Have the necessary certifications and licenses to operate in Cameroon
- Have a strong commitment to social responsibility and ethical business practices
