TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE SUPPLY OF INCLUSIVE FARMING GROUPS MATERIALS

SUBJECT

The CBC Health Services is launching a call to tender for the supply of Inclusive Farming 'Tools, Seedlings and means of Transport' to support the activities of Inclusive Farming Groups in 3 Divisions of the Far North Region. This activity is implemented within the context of the "Building Resilience of Refugees, IDPs, and the Host Communities through Improved Access to Health, Education and Income-Generating Activities" Project, implemented in partnership with CBM International and with funding from the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).
