PUBLIC NOTICE

The Cameroon Baptist Convention (CBC) Health Services is recruiting candidates to train for 7 months as Central Processing Department Technicians for CBC Health Services institutions. The training is open to other targeted hospital systems, Catholic, Presbyterian, Lutheran, other faith-based hospitals. Government and Private candidates can also apply.

This training includes:

- Didactic session from September 2, 2024 to December 21, 2024;
- Clinical session from January 2, 2025 to June 30, 2025.

1. Minimum Requirements

- GCE – O/Levels with a pass in at least 4 subjects.

2. Registration fees / training costs

- CBCHS Facilities, 70,000 FCFA per student.
- NON-CBCHS facilities, 80,000 FCFA per student plus housing
- Sending hospitals shall be responsible for the fees of candidates they are sending. Private individuals shall be responsible for their fees.

3. Admission criteria

- Must be recommended by the administration of a targeted hospital, or be approved as a private candidate by Perioperative Course Instructors in a committee.

Application documents include copies of the following;

- GCE O Level Certificate with a pass in at least four papers.
- Handwritten (or typed) one-page letter indicating your intentions and aspirations of taking part in the Central Processing Department training.

4. How to apply

- Interested candidates should indicate with the administration of their hospital and be enlisted for training by the administration of the target hospital.
- Hospital lists of selected potential candidates and Private, Individual Candidates must send their application documents no later than August 15, 2024 to Perioperativecourse@gmail.com.

6. Final approved candidates list from the Perioperative course leadership.

Approved candidates information shall be sent to the Director of CBC Health Services, including non-CBC candidates by September 2, 2024.
