PUBLIC NOTICE

The Cameroon Baptist Convention (CBC) Health Services is recruiting candidates to train for 10 months as Perioperative Scrub Technicians for CBC Health Services institutions. The training is open to all CBC Health Services Hospitals. Other targeted hospital systems; Catholic, Presbyterian, Lutheran, other faith-based hospitals; Government Hospitals and Private candidates can also apply.

This training includes;

- Didactic session from September 2, 2024 to December 21, 2024;
- Clinical session from January 2, 2025 to June 30, 2025

1. Minimum requirements

- GCE O/Levels with a pass in at least 4 papers
- Nursing Assistant Certificate

2. Registration fees / training costs

- CBCHS facilities, 90,000 FCFA per student
- Non-CBC Hospitals, 110,000 FCFA per student, plus housing
- Sending hospitals shall be responsible for the fees of candidates they are sending. Private individuals shall be responsible for their fees.

3. Admission criteria

- Must be recommended by the administration of a targeted hospital, or be approved as a private candidate by Perioperative Course Instructors in a committee.

Application documents include copies of the following;

- GCE O Level Certificates with a pass in at least four subjects.
- Nursing Assistant or APNA Certificate.
- Handwritten or typed one-page letter indicating your intentions and aspirations of becoming a Perioperative Scrub Technician.

4. How to apply

- Interested candidates should indicate with the administration of their hospital, and be enlisted for the Training. Hospital lists of selected potential candidates, and Private individual Candidates must submit their application documents no later than 5: p.m on August 15, 2024 to Perioperativecourse@gmail.com.

5. Final approved candidate list from Perioperative course leadership

Approved candidates information shall be sent to the Director of CBC Health Services, including non-CBC candidates by August 24, 2024.
